National Planning Policy Framework

We have submitted comments. It is considered that NALC's comments are superficial and should have been more helpful. BALC will be taking this matter up.

Daws Hill Reference Group

Mrs Wallis and Mr Mash have attended meetings of this group and found them to be of interest. 550 houses are planned for the Daws Hill area, but the Abbey Barn Area development is in abeyance.

111/11 ABBOTSBROOK HALL

The decorating is complete with the exception of the area under the sink in the kitchen which needs to fully dry out before decorating.

112/11 PAVILION/RECREATION GROUND

The tables have been checked and found to be safe to use. One table is slightly defective and this has been marked with X. Damage to the tables appears to be due to people forcing them into the storage box.

113/11 BURIAL GROUND

a. Tree Survey

The trees in the woodland area need to be assessed to decide which trees should stay and which ones can be removed. Depending on girth, we may need to seek planning permission to remove any trees,

We also need to have a plan of the site and this would show which areas can be levelled.

Mr Banfield and Mr Mash will undertake this before leaf fall.

b. Planting on Ashes Plots

There has been some planting of small shrubs on ashes plots Although our Regulations do permit this, we need to keep this monitored. When we begin to use the new ashes area, a new set of Regulations for that specific area needs to be drawn up.

a. Parking at the Recreation Ground

b. Employment Law Briefing

Mrs Brownridge attended the Employment Law Briefing hosted by BALC recently and has produced a report. She and the Clerk will meet to review our current policies.

c. Little Marlow Village Amenities Committee

Mrs Brownridge gave a list of suggestions for allocation of funds raised at the Fete. One suggestion is to hold a Queen's Jubilee party at the Recreation Ground in 2012 which was welcome subject to certain conditions being met. Some of the other suggestions will need further investigation and may prove to be impractical. These include planting of a wildflower area at the Recreation Ground and bulb planting around the Parish. Another proposal was for convex mirrors at the entrance to the Recreation Ground, but it has been ascertained from BCC that these would not be permitted.

d. Little Marlow Lakes Community Partnership

It was reported that fishermen have complained about nuisance from undisciplined dogs at Spade Oak lake. Signs have been erected and the matter will be raised again at the forthcoming liaison meeting.

e. Remembrance Day Service

Mr Banfield reminded the Council that the Annual Remembrance Day Service will take place at St John the Baptist, Little Marlow on 13th November at 10.45am.

f. WDALC
